**Pre-requisites:** Interest in intercultural communication indigenous knowledge and its relation to the environment.



**Target audience:** Undergraduate and graduate students related to cultural studies, local development and social work, environmental sciences, and people interested in cultural tourism focused on indigenous culture.



**Activities:** Participatory and active learning methodology with territorial immersion in Mapuche communities and guided field trips.



**Timeframe:** September to April



**Duration:** 44 hours, two weeks
