Volcanology: Exploring the volcanoes of the Global South



Explore the geological, physical and geochemical processes that characterize volcanic activity of the volcanoes in southern Chile. A unique opportunity to study these natural phenomena up close and learn about their impact on communities and the environment.



Pre-requisites: Desirable basic knowledge of geology and natural sciences, adequate physical fitness.



Target audience: Undergraduate and graduate students, researchers and professionals with careers or experience in geology, volcanology, environmental sciences, natural disasters, risk management.



Activities: Active learning methodology with an interdisciplinary approach on volcanic activity and applied practices during local volcano hikes.
